English 8 should have 2 entries (ENG850A & ENG850B) and a semester class will be 1 selection only. Alternate elective requests will have an additional 5 entries. Once entered, course requests will automatically be saved.

Be advised that some semester electives may not be offered if sign-ups are not adequate or staffing is not available. LMS cannot guarantee that a student will receive any particular elective request.

Courses entered by student and family in StudentVUE by the end of the registration period will be considered final.

Change requests will only be considered for:

- 1. Wrong placement (incorrect level or duplicate course)
- 2. Medical reason
- 3. Incomplete schedule
