Good afternoon Leota families,

We are now well into second semester and with COVID rates dropping dramatically, things are starting to settle in a bit. It is hard to believe that we are about to wrap up February and that March is just around the corner. If you hadn't heard already, Governor Inslee announced yesterday that he will be dropping the state school mask mandate on March 21st and decisions on mask use thereafter will be made locally. I personally don't know what is in store for Northshore students and staff in regards to masking after March 21st, but I expect there will be follow-up information sent out from the district office in the next few weeks regarding this topic. Until March 21st, masks will still be required at school with the same expectations as we've had all year. Here are a couple other things to note in the coming weeks:

- PTSA is coordinating a virtual Career Fair which will be conducted the 8:00-9:30am March 22nd here at school. Details are being finalized but we look forward to this opportunity for parents and community members to share about their profession with our students.
- Girls basketball and wrestling games/matches will be starting March 1st. One of the
  requirements for both of these sports is that all athletes (except those who had COVID in
  the last 90 days) must take a rapid antigen test the day of competitions. We will conduct
  this testing during Pride time in the cafeteria. Girls basketball and wrestling parents were
  sent an email this week with more details and information about completing necessary
  consent forms.

As we head into midwinter break, I hope you and your family have a fun and relaxing week. Staff and students alike look forward to this time to rejuvenate and prepare for the next phase of the school year. We look forward to seeing our Leota students again on Monday, February 28th!
