Happy Friday! Please don't forget that there is no school on Monday, January 18th in honor of Martin Luther King, Jr. In order to balance class time, also please remember that Tuesday, January 19th students will attend ALL of their classes. Please see more information about the schedule below. This coming week is a busy one, so I'll keep things as short as possible to ensure the emphasis is on those events listed below.

Second Semester Materials Pick-Up/Drop-Off: Please mark your calendars for this Wednesday, January 20th from 10:00am-4:00pm. Students may return any materials not needed from 1st semester and will pick up new materials for their second semester classes. Your child's teacher will notify them if they need to return any items to school on this day. All students will receive a bag. It will include a printed copy of their second semester schedule, any mandatory district forms that need to be completed, and all materials given by their second semester teachers. Below are full details and instructions for this event. We look forward to seeing all families then.

Steps for families to prepare for the 2nd semester drop-off/pick-up day on Wednesday, January 20th:

- Car pick-up/drop-off only (no walkers or bicyclists)
- Please adhere to the following pick-up/drop-off schedule as closely as possible:
 - 10:00am-Noon (A-K Alpha by last name)
 - Noon-2:00pm (L-P Alpha by last name)
 - 2:00pm-4:00pm (Q-Z Alpha by last name)
 - Any walkers, bicyclists, or families that cannot attend on Wednesday, January 20th, can return and pick up items on the alternate dates of January 21st (2-6pm) and January 22nd (noon-3pm) via the main office.
- Students who would like to have school photos taken should utilize Sign-up Genius by Dorian in advance. Families will receive an appointment time by Dorian for their designated photo time. <u>Click here to set up your appointment using Sign-up Genius</u>.
- If families or students who are sick, have been exposed to COVID or currently have COVID, please do not attend the event. Please email the main office secretary, Felicia Casolary, at <u>fcasolary@nsd.org</u> to arrange for an alternate pick-up.
- Expectations during pick-up/drop-off:
 - Please review the map at this link to ensure proper flow of traffic for pick-up/drop-off
 - Please follow all directions by traffic attendants and greeters
 - Please stay in your car with your seatbelts engaged and your masks on
 - All items to be returned to the school should be accessible without leaving vour car
 - Please hand items through the window to your station greeter
 - Curricular items (textbooks, library books, teacher loaned classroom items, etc.) should all be placed in one bag for return, if possible, for ease of exchange
 - Items will be scanned in and checked for condition (damage, etc.)
 - Your child can check their own account to see what is checked out to them (textbooks and library books). They will need their student ID number and their Google account password to log in. Click here for directions.
 - Technology Items only need to be returned if you are leaving the district. Please return your technology items in their own bag (Chromebook, hotspot, etc.). If you are not leaving the district, all students will keep their technology until the end of the school year.
 - School Photos are by appointment only. Families will pull as far forward using the main office drive-thru and follow all instructions by photo greeters. Only the student will exit the car and enter Portable 2 (P2) using the back ramp, have their photo taken and exit the front P2 door, looping back to their car. One student will be allowed in P2 at a time. Masks are required at all times along with proper social distancing for safety.
 - Food Bank Donations must be in a bag ready to be handed to a staff member through the car window.

- 6th grade social studies packets that need to be returned can be handed to a staff member through the car window. 6th grade social studies teachers will communicate if this applies to their class.
- Unfortunately, at this time the district has advised that no treats, gifts, flowers, etc. may be accepted due to the requirement that all items must be quarantined for nine days
- No high-fives or hugs can occur due to distancing requirements
- Most importantly, please exercise patience as this is new to us all
- Who can pick up items?
 - o Parent, guardian, or anyone already listed as an emergency contact
 - Anyone if the student is in the car (neighbor can bring your student)

Honor Society Food Drive: Our fabulous Honor Society students have coordinated a food drive to donate to a local food bank. *Please consider dropping off canned or non-perishable foods when you come to the Materials/Photo Day on Wednesday, January 20th.* Food should be in a bag or box that can easily be handed to a staff member. Please check expirations as expired food cannot be accepted. Thank you for helping our students support our community.

Martin Luther King, Jr. Virtual Assembly: January 20th will be our virtual MLK assembly. All students will report in the morning as normal to their 4th period and will remain with their teacher for the duration of the assembly, which will run from 8:30-9:00. Follow up activities will be conducted during homeroom on Thursday. We've partnered with the Association of Washington Student Leaders (AWSL) where a dynamic speaker will deliver a wonderful message with additional interactive components. We will end promptly at 9:00 to allow families to watch the Presidential Inauguration if they choose.

End of First Semester – Finish Strong: Please encourage your child to finish first semester strong by attending each class, completing and submitting any current or missing work, and consistently engaging to the very best of their ability. The last day of the semester is Friday, January 22nd. Second semester officially begins on Tuesday, January 26th. Teachers will be working on grades on Monday, January 25th so all work needs to be completed no later than the 22nd. Thank you for partnering with us to help you child finish strong.





Math Olympiad Club: Sign Up



We have heard from you that MATH/STEM-related enrichment is high on the wish list; We heard from you that your student is enthusiastic about Math, Math puzzles, Math problems and Applied Math scenario analysis - so here at Leota PTSA is excited to offer you with all of these opportunities.
