It has been a very long and emotional week for me and have toiled over writing this message because it has taken me a while to come to grips with the fact that I must take some time to focus on returning myself to health. I won't go into all the details, but want you to know that ultimately, I will be ok. However, it's going to take my body a while to return to baseline. I had been struggling with my autoimmune system for several months and continued to push through, despite my body's decline. Last Tuesday resulted in an ER visit that was the wake-up call I apparently needed to force me to focus on my health and well-being. I already miss each of our students, staff, and families immensely, but know that I must take time to focus on getting well. I will be on a medical leave of absence for a while and will continue to be monitored by my medical team, adjusting the return date as appropriate.

I want to say that I'm so incredibly thankful for Bryan McNiel. He will be taking on the interim Principal position while I'm out and will do a fantastic job! He's highly skilled and is ready to lead. The district is working to bring in an interim Assistant Principal to support Mr. McNiel. Most importantly, I want you to know that your children are all in good hands, which is a huge relief for me, allowing me to focus my efforts on healing.

I will miss you all, but know you are in good hands. Stay Leota strong!
